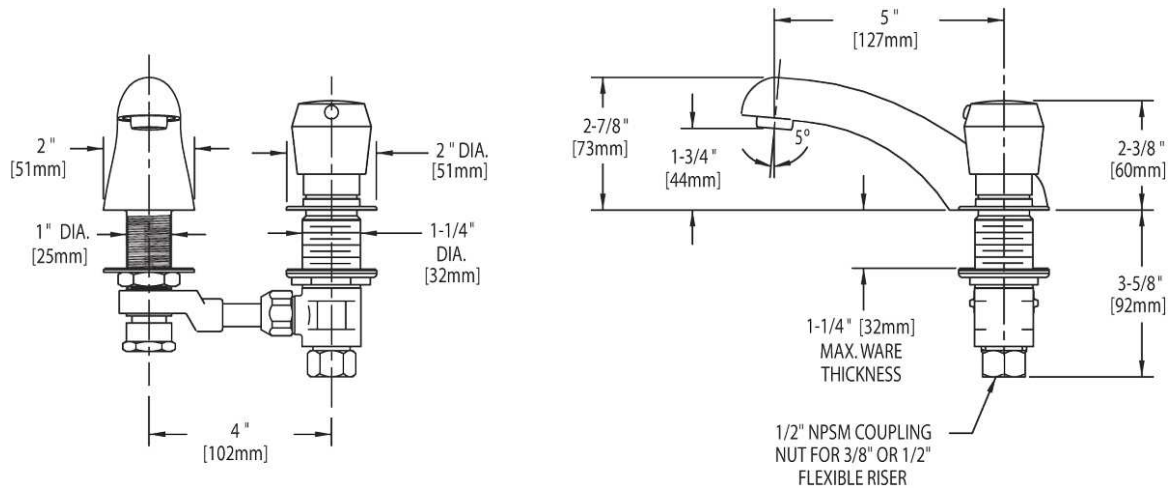

## Concealed Lavatory Metering Sink Faucet

### Architect/Engineer Specification

Chicago Faucets No. 404-665CWCP, polished chrome plated solid brass body and spout. 5" C-C spout. 2.2 GPM pressure compensating aerator outlet. Tapered metering handle with color coded index button. MVP™ push button, 0.25 Gal/Cycle self-closing metering cartridge with square tapered broach feature to help facilitate handle removal. 8" rigid valve body centers with 1/2" NPSM threaded inlets with coupling nuts for connection to 3/8" or 1/2" standard flexible risers. Mounting hardware included. This product meets ADA ANSI/ICC A117.1 requirements and is tested and certified to industry standards: ASME A112.18.1M, CSA B125.1, and Certified to NSF/ANSI 61, Section 9 by CSA.



### Operation and Maintenance

Installation should be in accordance with local plumbing codes. Flush all pipes thoroughly before installation. After installation, remove spout outlet or flow control and flush faucet thoroughly to clear any debris. Care should be taken when cleaning the product. Do not use abrasive cleaners, chemicals or solvents as they can result in surface damage. Use mild soap and warm water for cleaning and protecting the life of Chicago Faucet products.
