It's just like the standard model but accommodates a plug of living turf on top of the riser, keeping the sprinkler out of sight when retracted. Specify I-40 Turf Cup Kit part number 46-0000 for golf greens and tees, grass tennis courts, bowling greens, croquet courts or any area requiring invisible sprinklers.
